PHOENIX—(March 13, 2008) ExecuCar of Phoenix is “Going Green” with the purchase of three new Hybrid Chevy Tahoe’s. Visitors to the Phoenix area can now request a clean ride when going to and from the airport to hotels, shopping and golf courses, all provided by ExecuCar of Phoenix.

Currently ExecuCar has 130 livery sedans and is looking forward to adding more hybrid vehicles in the months ahead. The new hybrid vehicles will be recognizable by the green H on the cars saving approximately 8 miles per gallon with every trip.

In June, Execucar will celebrate 20 years of being in business in the valley of the sun. ExecuCar also operates sedan services in Dallas, Denver, Los Angeles, Sacramento, San Diego, San Francisco and Tampa Bay.
